IN RE COMPLAINT AGAINST TWO JUDGES

MEMORANDUM

Complainant has filed a judicial misconduct complaint against two judges. The complainant filed an earlier complaint which I dismissed against one of the judges. Subsequently complainant added a second judge to the original complaint and added different attachments. Like those in the original complaint, the allegations in this complaint are not very clear. There are allegations of criminal and other misconduct, but they are not linked to either judge and no facts are provided. This complaint lacks sufficient evidence to raise an inference that misconduct has occurred.

Complainant is warned that if he files similar complaints in the future which have no basis, it will result in the issuance of a rule to show cause why the Seventh Circuit Judicial Council should not curtail his misuse of the Judicial Conduct and Disability Act of 1980.

Therefore, this complaint is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §352(b)(1)(A)(iii).
